

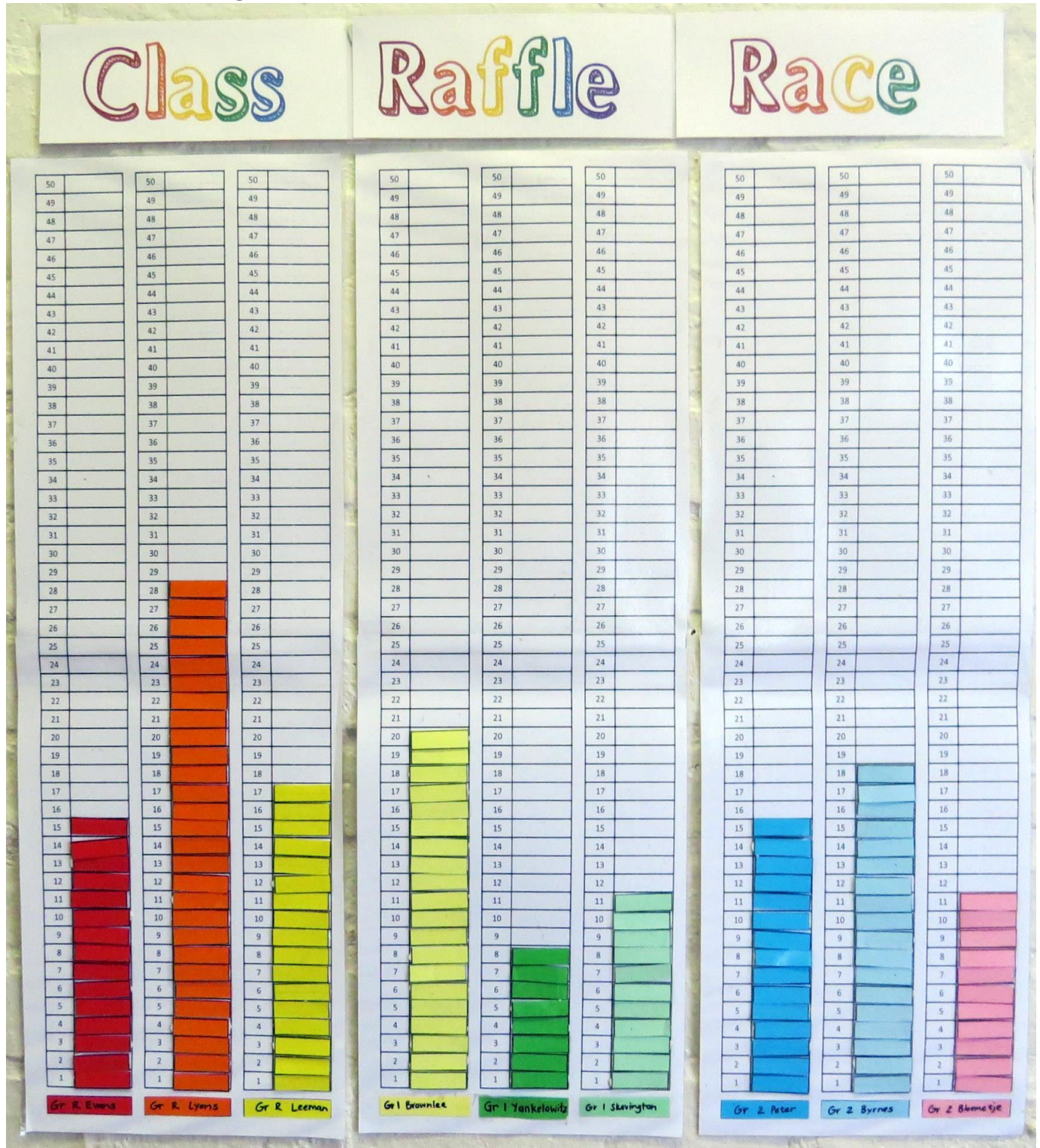

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION: TERM 3 REPORTS (MESSAGE FROM OUR PRINCIPAL)**

I am pleased to inform you that we have started the launch of the new parent portal on the school's administration and communication platform known as Staffroom. This will enable direct communication by the teacher to you on your child's academic progress.

As a start, reports will be available on Staffroom and will no longer be issued as hardcopies at the end of this term. (except for those parents who are unable to access email who will receive a hardcopy)

**Parents will need to register on the parent portal on Staffroom to access your child's report. The link will be sent to you on Thursday 29 August 2019 and all you need to do is use your email address that you have provided to the school as your username and create a password of your choice. Once this has been done an email link is sent to your email to enable you to validate the account – you simply need to click on the link to gain access.** This will enable you to access your child's report once available at the end of the term. This will mean no more hardcopies and saving of paper and trees! All your child's previous reports are already loaded on Staffroom for your convenience and easy access. If you encounter difficulties accessing the parent portal Staffroom, please contact Rene de Wet at the primary campus or Nina Sardo at the prep campus who will assist you.

The roll out of this teacher-parent communication platform will continue in term 4 which will include further teacher-parent communication such as homework and other announcements, including information relevant to a specific grade. In 2020 we plan to roll out further features.

**How do I register on the Staffroom parent portal?**

**Step 1:** Open the web browser (Safari, Chrome, FireFox) on either of your mobile devices, tablet or your PC and click the register link.

**Step 2:** You will then create an account and password for the portal using your email address provided to the school.

**Step 3:** Once this has been done an email link is sent to your email to enable you to validate the account - you simply need to click on the link.

**Step 4:** Once this has been done you can log onto the parental portal at any time using this username and password
