How do I register on the Staffroom parent portal?

Step 1: Open the web browser (Safari, Chrome, FireFox) on either of your mobile devices, tablet or your PC and click the register link.

Step 2: You will then create an account and password for the portal using your email address provided to the school.

Step 3: Once this has been done an email link is sent to your email to enable you to validate the account - you simply need to click on the link.

Step 4: Once this has been done you can log onto the parental portal at any time using this username and password
