It is an opportunity for you to see some of the work they have completed in the few days they have attended school and most importantly, a chance for you, besides meeting your child's Educator, to hear about the framework of the year's grade work and curriculum, homework procedures, an outline the daily program, Paired Reading procedures, methods of reporting and informing you of our **Class Representatives (POP's-Parents of the Prep School)** system that works so well at Camps Bay Prep. This information shared by the individual Educators at this meeting is highly valuable and cannot be replicated in a written document/hand-out. Please make every effort to attend even if you feel that you have heard it all before.

You will be addressed by Mrs Murray in the school hall then proceed to your child's class and meet with your child's Educator. Parents with children in more than one class, are welcome to move from class to class to hear both teacher's information. **This is not to discuss individual's progress**-it is a general information evening to guide you in the year forward.
