PLEASE ASSIST:

We need parental assistance on a few matters that have become of concern recently.

1. We cannot stress the importance of punctuality to our children. If we as adults cannot display this vital skill to our children, they do not show the required respect to this and will also not be punctual. Many children are not collected at 13h15 and have to wait, sometimes for an hour, on the green circle until they are collected. This is a time when problems can arise as all teachers are unavailable at this time to supervise uncollected children.
2. Please do not send unwell children to school. We have encountered this lately and have had to call parents to collect children who are really unwell and contagious (pink eye, ringworm, nits, etc.)
3. Please keep the office informed of address changes, cell phones that have been stolen or number changes. We need to at all times have immediate contact with our families for the safety of our children.
4. Our 10h30 morning break is a snack and not a meal. We do not warm food for our children at this time; however, we have made provision for this for our Aftercare children as this is lunch time.

BREAD BAG TAGS:

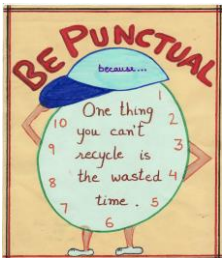
