### **MESSAGE FROM STUART COLLIER RE - LINDA MURRAY'S RETIREMENT:**

I wish to officially inform you that Ms Linda Murray reaches the WCED compulsory retirement age in August of this year. The school has successfully engaged with the WCED to extend Ms Murray's contract until the end of the year which will facilitate a smooth transition for the school.

Since 1984, during the thirty years of her career at the Camps Bay Schools, Ms Murray has been a grade R, I and 2 teacher and acted as Deputy Principal at the Prep School. When the Prep and Primary schools were amalgamated, Ms Murray was appointed as Head of Department at the Prep campus.

Thank you to Ms Murray for her loyalty and commitment over the years at the Prep campus, and particularly as Head of the Prep campus over the last six years. An official farewell for Ms Murray will be arranged in term 4 towards the end of the year.

The post has been advertised in the vacancy list and the sifting and interview process to appoint a successor is in progress, with the intention of making an appointment of a new Foundation Phase Head of Department as of 1 January 2020.

### **HOMEWORK FOR GRADE 1'S AND 2'S:**

Each Grade 1, 2 and 3 child in the Foundation Phase (FP) at Camps Bay Primary receives homework weekly from Monday to Thursday. All homework is

*consolidation of work done in class*, nothing new or unfamiliar is presented and

homework also keeps parents in touch with their child's current curriculum work and expectations.

Please look out for messages from your child's teacher in the homework book.



Children who are absent due to illness will receive updates on missed homework and will receive the tuition in class on return, as concepts are continuously taught during the week in FP and are not "one off" lessons.

Parents of children who miss regular daily class work due to extended holidays in term teaching and learning time, will need to comply with WCED regulation for children who miss compulsory South African schooling. Teachers in this instance do not provide "catch up work".

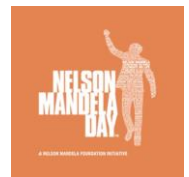
## MANDELA DAY DRESS UP THURSDAY 18 JULY:
