Our Term 3 Yumzie sales will commence on **Friday, 2 August** up to and including Friday, 13 September.

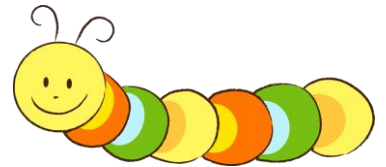

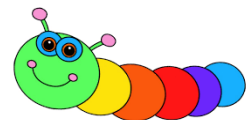
