BREAD BAG TAGS:



The process is as follows: The bread tags are collected from the Prep Campus, and sorted to ensure that metal objects, screws, nails and paperclips are removed as they would damage the recycler's machinery. A recycler buys the tags from Bread Tags SA and these funds are used to buy wheelchairs, Rollators and other surgical appliances for children. After processing the tags, they are turned into moulds and become seedling trays and germination trays for the plant nurseries.
