PREP CAMPUS EXPANSION:

We've got the keys! We are very happy to announce that Camps Bay Primary School finally have been given the keys for the premises previously occupied by the Camps Bay Bowling Club. The City of Cape Town is leasing the premises to the Western Cape Education Department for use by Camps Bay Primary School. The lease was signed and the keys handed over to the SGB chairperson, Vanessa September, on Monday 8 October 2018.

The extra space will alleviate the overcrowding on our existing two campuses and allow the provision of extra classrooms and facilities to meet the needs of the school's Foundation Phase. We plan to appoint architects next week to prepare plans for submission and approvals from relevant authorities as the building and grounds will need to be reworked to accommodate the school's needs. However, we anticipate being able to use the sports field and parking area for school use from this term. There are a number of people who have worked on this project over many years and we have to thank them all for their incredible commitment and dedication to ensuring this dream has finally become a reality.

The project was initiated by Susie Joubert, Sandy van Hoogstraten and the previous principal of Camps Bay Preparatory School, Nancy Roussopoulos. In the years that followed Michelle Harvey, Suzanne Maier and Fiona Hart took over driving this project, with Fiona Hart still involved at present. In the last few years, the team has been assisted by legal experts Nick Traverso, Terry Winstanley and Eduard Fagan as well as our current SGB secretary - Cathryn Hodgkinson, previous SGB chairperson - Ian Liddle, and current SGB chairperson Vanessa September.
