Dear Parent and Guardians,

IN ASSEMBLY:

VALENTINE'S DAY CHARITY TODAY:

We held our Term 1 Charity Assembly in the hall this morning when Ms Fiona and Tiber visited us from the Guide Dog Association. WATER:

Please ensure that your child brings sufficient water to school in a plastic (not glass) bottle. One tap has been left operational in the girls and boys bathrooms and we are awaiting our installation of the sanitisers. Please see the attached Camps Bay Primary School's Water Management Plan.

- **Children who remain at school for aftercare are encouraged to bring an extra bottle of "frozen water" along to school.**

SENIOR AFTERCARE GATE:

Please note that we request all families to use the **Senior Aftercare gate** (on Crown Crescent) from **12h45** onwards. The main entrance gate is open daily under Mr Heaton's supervision from 12h30 – 13h45 daily. The gate is closed at **13h45 sharp** for security purposes.

HOLDING CLASSES:

We have 2 holding classes every Tuesday and Thursday directly after school to cater for Gr 1 & Gr 2 children who need to wait a short while for their extra-mural. Judo and Yogalini children wait on Tuesdays (Gr 2 Byrnes classroom) and Experi-buddies and Modern Dance children, on Thursdays (Gr 2 Peter classroom). Thank you to our Grade 2 assistant, **Ms Letti Kanyerere**, who runs these much needed classes.

ASSISTED READING GROUP AT CAMPS BAY PREP:

We are fortunate to be able to assist children who need one on one additional reading experience with parents, guardians, grandparents and neighbours. Mrs Moodley is the Assisted Reading Co-ordinator who co-ordinates this program which happens at the start or end of the school day. The reading session with one child is 20 minutes long and we are looking for more volunteers! Please contact us if you have time to assist a child with their reading!

CBPS WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN:

The Premier of the Western Cape, Helen Zille, and the WCED have instructed all schools to draw up and implement an Emergency Water Management Plan in preparation for and the in the event of Day Zero.

Please consult the attachment for the CBPS Water Management Plan for full details.

A number of measures have already been implemented at the school to reduce the use of water. The SGB have taken the decision to invest in tanks and plumbing to facilitate the use of alternative water sources for sanitation. Camps Bay High School has offered the primary/prep use of water from the boreholes at the high school. The SGB are, in addition, investigating the use of alternative water sources such as a borehole and well-point. At present the Operations Manager, Ms Gail Bester, is also at present sourcing drinking water kegs to be placed at both campuses for emergency drinking water. All learners, teachers and staff will be required to bring 500ml of own drinking water to school daily. However, let's keep using 50l per person per day and hopefully we can avoid Day Zero!
