FATs: FORMAL ASSESSMENT TASKS

All Grade 1’s and 2’s have commenced FATs this week. Please ensure that all children are present daily and punctually for these very important Term 2 assessments. Assessment of absentees will be arranged by the teachers and we are forced to use Sport time, Music lessons, assembly time, Speech and Drama lessons and Movement to Music periods to catch up on completion of FATs for absentee children.

CHICKEN POX:

We have 8 confirmed cases of Chicken Pox in Grade 1 and 2.

Symptoms to look out for: Fever, headache, sore throat or stomach ache. The rash begins as multiple small red bumps that look like pimples or insect bites and appear in crops over 2 to 4 days and then develop into thin-walled blisters filled with fluid. The walls break, leaving open sores, then crust over to dry brown scabs. The rash is very itchy and calamine lotion can be used to manage the itching.

Please inform the school immediately should your child have Chicken Pox.

LOST PROPERTY:

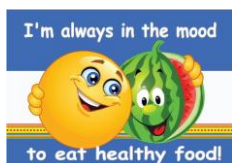
- **Ben McKay** (Gr 2RB), has lost his brown unmarked school shoes. If found, please return to Gr 2 Mrs Byrnes class.
