At Camps Bay Primary we take pride in our appearance and would like to commend our boys and girls on wearing the correct uniform and looking neat.

Our Hair Policy is as follows:

Girls

- ☺ Hair should be clean, neatly trimmed, off ears, off the collar and not hanging in the eyes in the interests of hygiene and preventing the spread of nits and lice
- ☺ Colouring and stylised shaving are prohibited.
- ☺ It is at the Principal's discretion as to what is deemed acceptable.

- ☺ Hair should be clean and neatly styled. Hair that touches the collar should be tied up with bottle-green, white or brown coloured hair accessories in the interests of hygiene and preventing the spread of nits and lice.
- ☺ Hair that hangs in eyes must be tied back with bottle-green, white or brown or silver or black coloured clips or Alice-band.
- ☺ Colouring and stylised shaving are prohibited.
- ☺ It is at the Principal's discretion as to what is deemed acceptable.
